

Roefaro and Maciol lowering the cost for prescription drugs in Utica and New York Mills

November 4, 2009 – (Utica, NY) - City of Utica Mayor David Roefaro and Village of New York Mills Mayor Robert Maciol announced today that they have secured the rights to a national prescription savings program for Utica and New York Mills residents.

The program, paid for by Envision Medical Solutions will be offered at no cost to Utica and New York Mills taxpayers.

Roefaro and Maciol announced that under the program, residents and customers of the City and Village can pick up their Envision prescription drug discount card at their respective City Halls.

“These cards, which can be used to obtain discounts on various prescription drugs purchased at pharmacies, will undoubtedly save Uticans real dollars,” said Utica Mayor David Roefaro. “A few dollars each time you need a prescription can surely add up.”

“For New York Mills, this program eases our residents’ budget burdens with a tangible savings,” said New York Mills Mayor Robert Maciol. “These are real dollars residents will be saving.”

The free discount cards are available at Utica City Hall in the clerk’s office and in the New York Mills Town Hall.

The prescription savings card may be used any time a prescription is or is not covered by insurance. It can even be used towards pet medication.
